A two-day camp during March break is being organized by the Asian Institute and the Centre for South Asia Studies at the University of Toronto. Students from the upper years of Grades 11 and 12 are invited to be part of an interesting and exciting extra-curricular program that will help them explore and generate informed awareness of this globally important region.

Students will have an opportunity to listen to speakers from Canada's premier research university and learn about cutting-edge research in the fields of Asian studies, including politics, business, history, culture, art, and cinema. A session will be organized for the students to explore career paths and speak with specialists who either work in Asia or whose work involves the region. Asia-themed lunches will reflect on the culture of food. There will also be a guided workshop for students to engage in Asia-inspired art, with an off-campus visit to the ROM being planned.
